What NOT to put in your recycling bin:



 *Help us to reduce our Contamination Rate by not placing the following items in your Recycling bin:*

- × No plastic bags, plastic film or shrink wrap
- × No polystyrene goods (eg meat trays & packaging)
- × No ceramics, window glass, light globes, mirrors or broken glass
- × No garden waste of any sort
- × No household garbage, food scraps or food wrappings
- × No batteries
- × No scrap metal
- × No unwanted paint or paint tins
- × No nappies
- × No syringes/needles or medical waste
- × No clothing or leather
- × No oil, acid or chemicals
- × No liquid of any kind
- × No building rubble
- × No animal waste or kitty litter



Recycling Collection

Please check your recycling calendar for the correct recycling week. The yellow top bin should be placed on the **kerb** next to your household garbage bin as pictured **PRIOR TO 6.00AM**.



Interesting Facts

The material collected each fortnight in your yellow top recycling bin is taken to our MRF (Materials Recovery Facility) where it is sorted, baled and then sold to local and overseas markets for re-use.
