**Purpose** 

To determine the nature and extent of Council's representation at international/interstate/state conferences, study tours, seminars or conventions

## **Policy**

The following guidelines are to be considered for any proposal for representatives of the Council to attend conferences, study tours, seminars or conventions -

- when it is considered desirable that the Council be represented at an international/interstate and/or state conference, study tour, seminar or convention, a maximum of two councillors and one officer may attend.
- 2. following attendance at such conferences, the councillors and officer be required to submit a report on the conference proceedings for the Council's information and records.
- 3. a list be maintained on the Council's records of councillors' attendance at conferences.
- 4. the representatives be determined by the Council and a list of previous attendances be submitted on each occasion to assist with that decision.
- 5. where it is not appropriate for the Chief Executive Officer to attend a particular conference, other senior officers be given the opportunity to gain valuable experience as part of their career development.
- 6. Attendance is subject to budget provisions
