Policy	Administrative Policies - 2.10 Acting Chief Executive Officer
Purpose	To maintain continuity in the office of the CEO
Status	

Policy

That where the CEO is to be absent from office The CEO is authorised to appoint an Acting CEO from one of the Management Team with authority to exercise the powers and duties of that position. For periods exceeding 4 weeks, Council is to appoint Acting CEO.

Special Note

Depending on the length of absence involved a relieving officer or senior employee will be appointed.

Delegations to the CEO will carry over to the Acting CEO for the period they are acting.
